About The Arc Oregon

The Arc Oregon is an affiliated chapter of The Arc, the nation's oldest and largest organization for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). For 70 years, The Arc Oregon has worked to promote and protect the **human rights** of people with IDD, and to actively support their full inclusion and participation the community throughout their lifetimes. Our innovative programs, services, and trainings empower people with IDD and other disabilities to pursue their goals, achieve independence, and build valuable community relationships.

Self-Advocacy Convention

In 2025, we will host our **second annual Self-Advocacy Convention**, a **statewide conference** highlighting the voices and lived experiences of individuals with IDD. Self-advocates from across Oregon come together to network, share stories, learn from each other, and celebrate being in community. This event is thoughtfully designed **by and for people with IDD.** We encourage family, professionals, and chapter leaders to attend and learn from self-advocate voices.

Last Year's Success

The 2024 Self-Advocacy Convention was our FIRST EVER convention centering self-advocate leadership, and its success exceeded expectations. We welcomed 170 in-person attendees and were able to provide grants and scholarships to almost 100 self-advocates and their families to attend. Participation not only maxed out, but surpassed the venue capacity so quickly that registration had to close early!

This Year's Expansion

You can help The Arc Oregon shape our Self-Advocacy Convention into a thriving annual event led by self-advocates. Here's how the 2025 Convention will build on last year's event:

- More self-advocate guidance and leadership during convention planning
- Self-advocates involved in event operation and organization, including catering, running A/V, and special events
- Increasing registration to over 200 attendees
- A larger venue to accommodate more attendees and breakout sessions
- More grants/scholarships for self-advocates and family members to attend

Why Sponsor the Convention?

Make Attendance Affordable

NEW Sponsorship Model

This year, we introduce a **sliding-scale sponsorship model** that allows you to decide how much you will contribute and what you want to sponsor. This includes **directly sponsoring key elements** of the Self-Advocacy Convention (see below for examples).

Exhibitor tables have a flat rate fee of \$250 per table, which includes 1 six-foot table, 2 chairs, and 1 event registration with meals. *Exhibitor tables are free for affiliated chapters of The Arc!*

Direct Sponsorship Examples
